**Men:** The crash at the finish line involved the top 34 places. Since the last 3 km of the race was essentially flat, although it was a KOM it is not deemed to be a mountain top finish. The top 9 riders came across together. All riders in the group of 34 riders received the same time as the winner of the stage.

The time cut for Stage Three was **3:44:55**. One rider was beyond the time cut but was disqualified. 151 riders finished Stage Three, but one rider suffering a mishap will not continue. All other GC riders may begin Stage 4 Criterium.
