

#### **4-WAY COMBINED AWARD (J3, J4, J5 (10-7))**

To be eligible for the combined award for the May Day event, you must participate in all four (4) events, Jump, X-C and both alpine events for your age group. Old World Cup points will be awarded to the top 15 places in each of the four events. Individuals will be ranked from the fastest or longest (jump) to the slowest or shortest (jump). One overall award is presented to the boy and girl high point holder in each of the three (3) age groups.

Old World Cup points are awarded as follows:
